The week beginning **November 19th** is the start of a two week mock examination period for Year 11. In French you will have a one hour paper for Listening, Reading and Writing containing some Year 10 topics and some Year 11 topics (Speaking will also be assessed)

The questions for each component can come from the following topics:

<b>Free time activity</b> (This includes music, cinema and TV; food and eating out and sport)	
<b>Customs and festivals</b> (This includes France and customs and francophone festivals)	
<b>Home, town, neighbourhood and region</b> (This includes home and where I live)
