Developments in new materials (1.3 in the revision guide, pages 23 - 30)

Systems approach to designing (1.4 in the revision guide, 31-35)

Mechanical devices (1.5 in the revision guide, pages 36 – 45)

The above areas will represent 50% of the exam paper – the remainder of the exam will be based around specific graphics questions from Year 10 ‘key skills’:

Perspective

Third angle projection

Typography in design (answering a specific design brief).

The above ‘CORE’ components have been covered in class over recent months.

‘Key Skills’ (perspective, third angle and typography) can be found in students own graphics folders.

Please use both your independent notes and the electronic revision guide I have provided you with to help you to prepare for the important mock exam.

Students will be given a theme for the design brief prior to half term. This will allow them to carry out independent research in preparation for this area of the exam.
