Amazing: To be able to present your research in Spanish

Individual research project (from the AQA Specifications)

- Students must identify a subject or a key question which is **of interest to them** and which relates to a country or countries where Spanish is spoken.
- They must select relevant information in Spanish from a range of sources **including the internet**. The aim of the research project is **to develop research skills**.
- Students will demonstrate their **ability to initiate and conduct individual research** by analysing and
- summarising their findings, in order to present and discuss them in the speaking assessment.

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- In order to encourage you to develop your research skills, we would like you to complete a log book (on slides 11 & 12) and gain insight into Spanish culture.
- This task will enrich your general and cultural knowledge of Spain and Spanish vocabulary.
- Please up-date your work on this powerpoint, print your cultural log book and bring it to your first Spanish lesson for discussion.
