Why?

Phone Pouch Process

Start of the day

1. Students to place phones in pouches at the start of the day. Tutors to check pouches in tutor time and ensure all pouches are locked. This will form part of the students stationery check each morning.



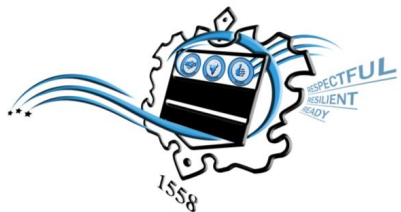
During the day

2. Students to keep phones in pouches for the duration of the school day in their school bag. Students cannot simply carry their pouch around.

End of the day

3. Students will be able to unlock pouches at unlocking stations near the exits of the building. Students are to bring pouches for each school day.





Uniform



Permitted Uniform:

A condition of student entry to classes at Alleyne's Academy is the wearing of full school uniform and strict adherence to our dress code. 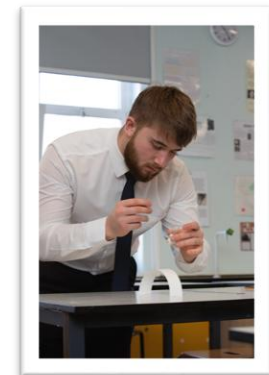
Skirts and Trousers

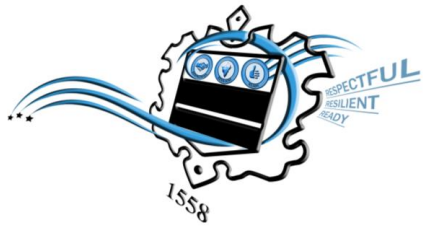
