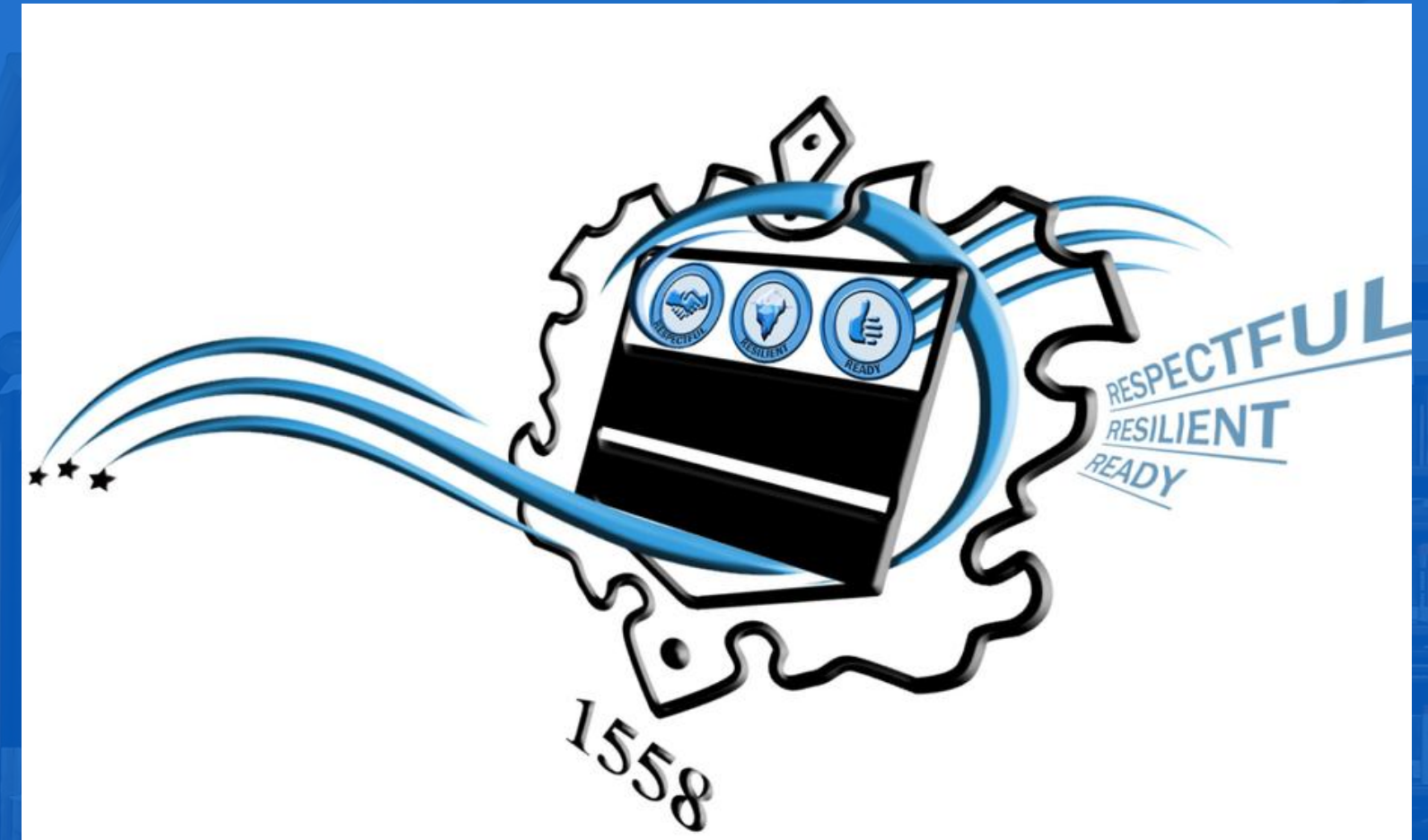

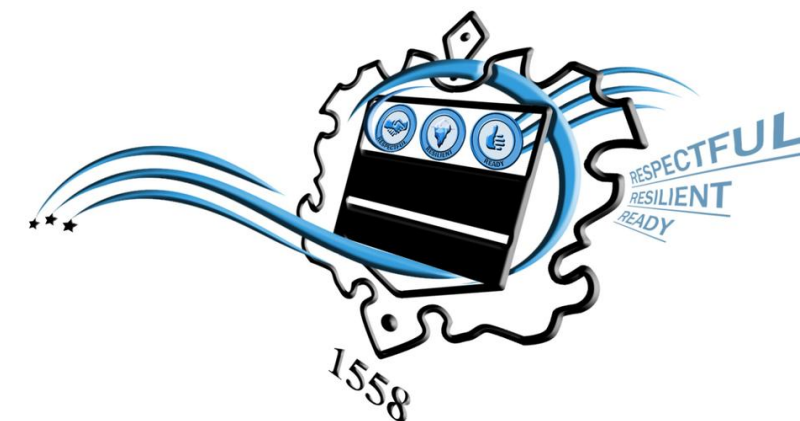

School Shoes

Clothing Items

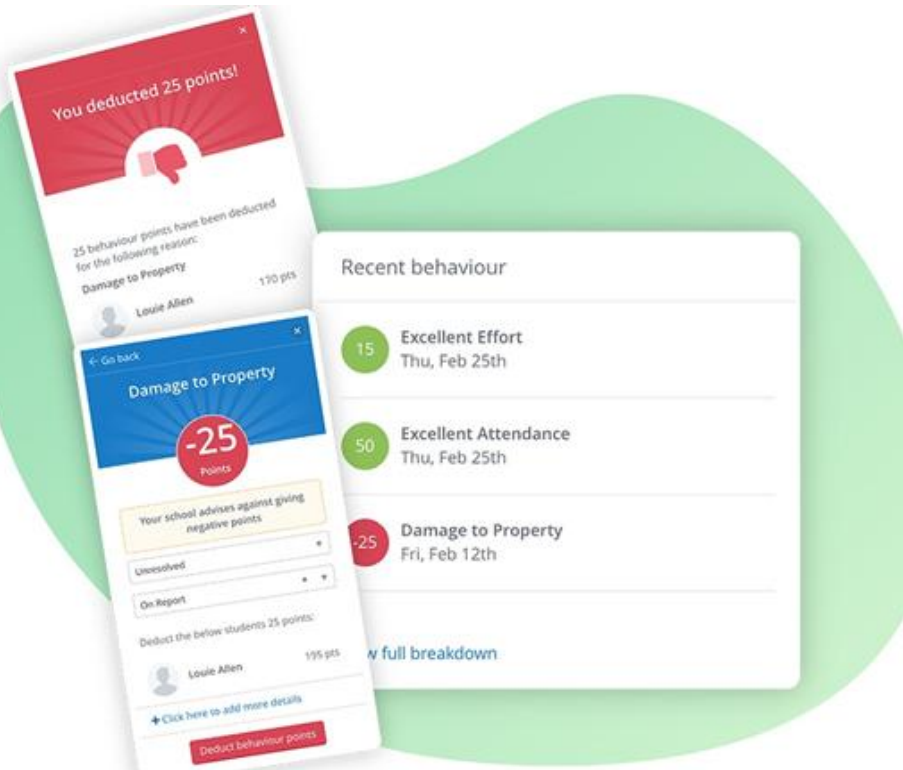
