ALLEYNE'S ACADEMY SIXTH FORM ADMISSIONS POLICY

Admission to the Sixth Form

Students with an Educational Health and Care Plan (EHCP) that specifies Alleyne's Academy as the placement school will be allocated a place, provided they have met the relevant academic standards required.

Admission to the Sixth form will then be from:

- Students currently in Y11 at the Academy (internal applicants), and then
- Students from outside the Academy (external applicants).

Entry requirements for admission to the Sixth Form shall be the same for both internal and external candidates.

No student may be admitted on a fee paying basis.

Repeating Sixth Form Education

On occasions a post-16 student may make a request to repeat a year in Alleyne's Academy's Sixth Form. The Academy is not legally obliged to agree to this and each request will be considered on an individual basis.

Reasons for this situation may have been caused by the following:

- A student underwent a significant period of absence due to illness or other personal circumstances beyond the student's control;
- A student restarted Y12 due to a change in his/her programme of study;
- A student restarted Y12 due to poor performance.

Upper Age Limit Restrictions

The Governing Body of Alleyne's Academy has agreed to restrict the upper age limit on students starting a post-16 course of study to 17 years of age at the time of entry.

Overseas Students

State funded schools are unable to offer a state education on a fee paying basis to overseas post-16 students. The following institutions only may make a charge:

- Independent schools;
- Sixth Form colleges;
- Further Education colleges.
