

Year 11 Drama Revision

Students will answer 3 sections within the Drama Mock:

1. Multiple Choice (types of staging, stage positions)
2. Questions based on the script 'Noughts and Crosses'
3. Live Theatre Review of 'The Woman in Black' which **students saw on 7 November**

Students should revise:

- Types of staging (e.g. thrust/proscenium arch) and stage position on stage (e.g. centre stage).
- Noughts and Crosses (we have class sets of books however if students wish to buy from Amazon, see picture below).
- Students can be asked a question from any part of the play and for any character therefore character profiles and key quotes for each character is a good idea.
- Students must also answer a set/costume design idea too therefore sketching set and costume choices will be good revision.
- Anything on Brecht as the play is Brechtian in style. There is useful information on GCSE Bitesize (<https://www.bbc.com/bitesize/guides/zwmvd2p/revision/1>) .
- Students also have 'Noughts and Crosses' log books to revise from in addition to material in their folders.

- In terms of 'The Woman in Black', the main bulk of work/revision will happen after **their practical exam on 6 March** however research on the film/play would be beneficial. **The same production is also on again in March at the Crewe Lyceum if students wanted to go and refresh knowledge and understanding.**
- Students should also visit the Drama folder within the 'School Share' electronic folder they have access to, for more revision materials and practice questions.
