- **If you have not got the grades you expected** please don't worry about this; we are here to help and advise. If you wish, either email Mr Haydon or myself to arrange a telephone conversation or alternatively come into school at the allotted time.
- **If you require any careers guidance** you can come in to school and we can help with your decision making.

If you do need to come into school, we will be maintain social distancing so it very important that you **keep to the times allotted below** which is based on **alphabetical order of surname**:
